The All Africa Dairy Expo (AADE) will be held from 12-13 February 2008 at the Afri-Dome in Parys in the Free State. The expo will offer valuable courses for dairy farmers and workers.

One of the excellent courses will teach of caring for your cows and calves after birth, and how to handle the birth process (obstetrics). The course will be presented by the Onderstepoort Veterinary Department and costs R125 a person. Topics covered in this course include normal births, large calves, and when to call the vet.

Also on the programme are other courses such as cheese making and meat processing. The meat processing course teaches one how to make Russians and salami, and how to preserve meat. The Agricultural Research Council will present these courses which will cost R75 per person per course.
