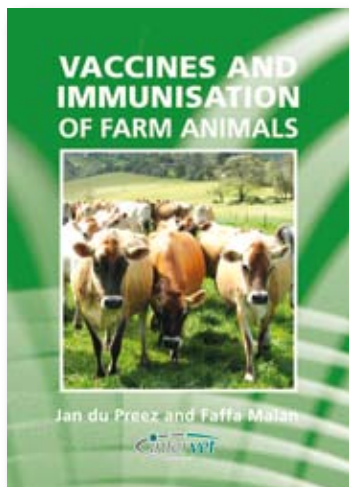


# Empower yourself with knowledge
