

# Grow vegetables in bags

You don't have to throw away empty feed bags once your chickens or livestock have been fed. Here is a very simple way to put these bags to good use by planting vegetables in them.

1. Use porous bags that can let some air through.
2. Fill the bags with a mixture of good soil and manure.



3. Lay the bags flat on the ground and make holes (approximately six holes per bag).
4. Plant vegetable seeds in each hole.
5. Insert a 2-litre plastic cold drink bottle filled with water, upside down at the end of each bag.



- Refill the bottles when necessary.
- Move the bags if you find that they are not sheltered enough.
